

Need: Services to the people in need are scattered far apart preventing anyone from getting to them in reasonable time. Social impediments that plague the homeless and disenfranchised exacerbate problems such as unemployment, depression, sleep-loss and poor nutrition. Concerns such as civil rights to privacy, property and liberty of impoverished individuals are often overridden by exploitative landlords who are primarily interested in profit at the expense of human rights. Even government-funded programs that are ostensibly designed to assist the differently abled and financially disadvantaged are not free from discrimination of social class and blatant violations of the Americans With Disabilities Act.

Solution: The dividing line between the well off and less fortunate can be erased by empowerment of all individuals. My idea is to foster a community hub to facilitate an altruistic, holistic atmosphere where sound nutrition, healthcare, social services, religious and other charities, can efficaciously benefit those with the greatest need. Businesses work together on one property to provide complete reintegration into higher society.

Projected results of the proposed solution: The goal of the social rehabilitation and reintegration consortium is to provide education, physiomenal and medical wellbeing and temporary housing in one location, minimizing stress on the concerned individual and repetitive paperwork.

Role of the hub

- Consolidate the application process for multiple services.
- Effective time-management promptly customizing a service menu for each individual.
- Working to minimize social stigmas pertaining to mental health concerns and homelessness.
- Thoughtful social participation assistance.
- Focus on education and social reintegration to reduce likelihood of psychiatric trauma, criminal tendencies, court and jail-time.

Classes: A neuropsychologist will design group therapy to reset minds to think in a healthful fashion. The goal is to treat individual trauma and encourage learning life skills that will lead to independence, social fluency and reintegration into society.
